EVS CHARTER

EVS partnership between

- Sending organisation
- Hosting organisation
- Coordinating organisation

An adequate match-making between the volunteer profile and the task has to be in place. An *activity agreement* is signed by all the partners before the beginning of the activity.

EVS CHARTER II

EVS principles to be ensured

- Non-formal educational and intercultural learning dimension.
- Clear definition of the non-profit making character and the volunteer tasks. Full-time service and active role of the volunteer in implementing the activities have to be ensured. EVS volunteer activities must not substitute any employment.
- Contact with the local community.
- EVS is free of charge for the volunteers.
- Accessibility and Inclusion
